Copy of Petition.

To the County Board of the County of Anoka,
Minnesota: The undersigned Petitioners re-
spectfully represent and state that they are
the owners of lands that have been heretofore
assessed for the construction of Ditch No. 32 of
Anoka County. That the said ditch and its
branches are in need of repairs, and that its use-
fulness for the purpose for which it was con-
structed has become greatly impaired by reason
of the following facts: First, that said ditch has
become obstructed by the deposit of sediment
therein and by the growth of weeds and grasses
upon and along the bottom, sides, banks and
right of way thereof; Second, that by reason of
pasturage along its banks and across and through
the same, many places are almost entirely filled,
Third, that on the construction of Ditch No. 55,
a portion of the lands originally tributary to
Ditch 32 has become tributary to Ditch 55 and has
been assessed for its construction, but to secure
the benefits from Ditch 55 will require the open-
ing, widening and deepening of portions of Ditch
32 and its branches tributary to Ditch 55, Fourth,
that to secure full benefits from the ditch, many
places in the main ditch and branches will require
opening, widening and deepening. Wherefore,
Your petitioners pray that you will appoint a
civil engineer to ascertain and report to you the
necessity, therefore, and the cost, making such
reports, and when such reports are filed, such other
and further proceedings may be had as may be
necessary for the repair of such ditch and
branches, and the opening, widening and deep-
ening of the same, as may appear necessary. Minnesota
