Witness, A petition bearing date the 22nd day of Jan 1898, signed by Samuel Beeble, John Levine of St. Cloud, J. J. Stager, E. J. Behm, M. Stalen, J. A. Stener, John Stor, Mike Stor, M. Seibel, Mrs. Annette M. St. William, R. W. Elberg, J. G. Well, Joseph Hennick, J. J. Macdon, J. J. Remden and John Remden praying for the establishment of a certain ditch in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And Witness, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Ancker County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

And Witness, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit and utility, and conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare;

Now, therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a Special session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint Sam Pratt J. J. Remden and John A. Stale

three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 10th day of May 1898, at St. Cloud in Sec. 11 Town 7 Blaine as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 30th day of June 1898
