PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of Sixty Branches along the following described route in the Town 5 of Plain, Township of Columbus in said County of Anoka and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and be conducive to the public health & convenience.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows
Commencing at the center of Section No. 14 down 31 Range 23 thence in a generally easterly direction through Section 14 & 13 down said Range 23 thence No. 7-18 and 17 down No. 31 Range 23 and terminating in the meadow lands for sale, also a branch commencing at the quarter corner between Section 36 down 32 Range 23 and Section 31 down 32 Range 22 and extending thence in a southeasterly direction through Section 31 down 32 Range 22 and 6 and 7 down 31 Range 22 to connect with the said main line in said Section 7 with such other branch or branches as the viewers may deem necessary to drain the lands assessed for the construction of said Ditch.
