Whereas the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka at their session held on the 29th day of June, 1898 upon the petition of John R. Hendle, Joseph Palmer, J. H. Sherman, Cyrille Bernier, and others, bearing date the 30th day of April, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch, along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office;

The places of commencement of said ditch at

its source is as follows:
Main line beginning on N. line of sec. 4, of sec. 12, T. 31, R. 22, thence southerly through said sec. 4, of sec. 4, and ne. ¼ of sec. 13; thence westerly and S. westerly through ne. ¼ of sec. 4, e. ¼ of sec. 4, and sw. ¼ of sec. 13; Sec. 13: w. ¼ of ne. ¼, Sec. 24 and sec. 4 of ne. ¼. Sec. 23 and terminating in Clear Water creek in sec. 4 of ne. ¼, Sec. 23, all in T. 31, R. 22.

Branch No. 1, on in w. pt. ne. ¼ of sw. ¼, Sec. 13, T. 31, R. 22, thence easterly through said ne. ¼ of sw. ¼ to main line of ditch and thence terminating.

Branch No. 2, on S. line of sec. 4, of sec. 12, T. 31, R. 22, thence runs west on section line about 70 rods; thence northerly and westerly thru ne. ¼ of sec. 4, and on the line between ne. ¼ of sw. ¼ and sec. 4 of sw. ¼, said Sec. 13, about 40 rods to run in ditch and thence terminating.
