

SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, That, on the 26th day of November 1898, at 11 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Waukegan in case no appeal is taken I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 33 of Waukegan County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Waukegan County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date October 14th 1898, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source, from Section 9 to Section 120+85 Main line through Sections 12, 13, 24 and into Section 23. Parcel No. 1 from Section 9. Section 11+73 in Section 13. Parcel No. 2 from Section 1 Section 40+32 in Section 24 1/3. all being in Town 31, Range 22

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
