WHEREAS, A petition bearing date the 21st day of March 1898, signed by John B. Neale, Geo. P. Pelton, J. M. Moberg, E. W. Benson, Frank Johnson, Augustus Benson, Miss Lovell, Marie Gray, Frank's Field, Cassie Peterson, Ole Strahl praying for the establishment of a certain ditch in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;
