**AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF PETITION.**  
State of Minnesota, County of Anoka—89.  
Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka at their session held on the 24th day of June, 1898, upon the petition of John B. Houde, Jos. F. Pelzer, J. H. Sherman, Cyrille Bernier, and others, bearing date the 30th day of April, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the Board of County Commissioners, at their special session to be held at the court house in the City of Anoka in said county, on the 15th day of October, 1898, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows:  
Main line beginning on N. line of sec. 4 of sec. 12, T. 31, R. 22, thence southerly through said sec. 4 and ne. 1/4 of sec. 13; thence westerly and S. westerly through aw. 1/4 of sec. 4, e. 1/2 of sw. 1/4 and sw. 1/4 of sw. 1/4, Sec. 13; w. 1/2 of nw. 1/4, Sec. 24 and sec. 4 of ne. 1/4, Sec. 23 and terminating in Clear River creek in sec. 4 of ne. 1/4, Sec. 23 all in T. 31, R. 22.

Branch No. 1 com. in w. pt. ne. 1/4 of sw. 1/4, Sec. 13, T. 31, R. 22, thence easterly through said ne. 1/4 of sw. 1/4 to main line of ditch and there terminating.  
Branch No. 2 com. on S. line of sec. 4 of sec. 12, T. 31, R. 22, thence runs west on section line about 70 rods; thence northerly and westerly through sw. 1/4 of sec. 4 and on the line between ne. 1/4 of sw. 1/4 and sec. 4 of sw. 1/4, said Sec. 13, about 40 rods to main ditch and there terminating.
