AUDITORS' NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF PETITION. State of Minnesota, County of Anoka, ss.

Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said county of Anoka at their session held on the 20th day of December, A. D. 1898, upon the petition of M. Fahnrich and others, bearing date the 15th day of September, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their regular session to be held at court houses in the city of Anoka in said county, on the 10th day of July, 1899, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch or drain at its source is as follows: Commencing at section line between section three (3) in Town of Grov and sec. thirty-four (34) in Town of Oak Grove in Clark's Brook (so-called) where the said Brook crosses said section line, thence to follow said Brook and clearing the same in said section 34, T. 33, R. 24 to Cedar Creek in said section 34 and there to terminate. The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch or drain passes are as follows: Dennis Mahoney estate, Thos. Lee.

The place of termination of said ditch or drain at its outlet is as follows: In Cedar Creek in the ne¹/₄ of nw¹/₄ of sec. 34, T. 33, Range 24.
