This Contract, Made this 14th day of November 1899, by and between Henry B. Fleming of Austin County party of the first part, and Alden W. Goffey County Auditor of the County of Austin State of Minnesota, in behalf of Austin County, Minnesota, WITNESSETH:

GATHERERS, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain ditch designated as No. 58 which number has been given to said ditch by the County Auditor.

by their order, bearing date the 12th day of August 1899, and according to the report of the viewers are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

And GATHERERS, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, commencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source, held October 7th 1899, the said Alden W. Goffey County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said Henry B. Fleming he being the highest and best responsible bidder, the job of digging and constructing the following sections thereof, numbered as follows from said outlet, to-wit: Station 44 to Station 85 inclusive Main line. For the sum of One Hundred Ninty seven & 1/10 Dollars (197.20)
