Stat. §103E.075, that the Anoka County has determined that the drainage system known as County Ditch 35 and its five branches, located in the City of Columbus and Linwood Township, has been obstructed. The County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on this matter on <u>July 25, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.</u> in Room 710 of the Anoka County Government Center, 2100 Third Avenue, Anoka, Minnesota 55303. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. §103E.075, if the board determines that the drainage system has been obstructed, the board shall direct the responsible party to remove the obstruction unless the responsible party shows the board why the obstruction should not be removed. The board shall hear all interested parties and, if removal of the obstruction is ordered, the board will set a reasonable time for removal of the obstruction(s). If the obstruction is not removed within the prescribed time, the board shall have the obstruction removed and the County shall make a statement of the removal cost. The statement must be filed in the county recorder's office as a lien on the property where the obstruction is located or against the responsible party. The lien may be enforced against the party by civil action.
