have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: Main Ditch Commencing at the north West corner of section No. 3, Township No. 32, Range No. 22, thence running in a North Easterly direction through said section No. 3, into and through sections No. 34 = 35 and part of sect. No. 26, terminating in County Ditch No. 12, at the Centre of said sect. 26, all in Township No. 32, R. 22 also Branch Ditch beginning at the N.W. 1/4 of sect 2, Township 32, R. 22, thence running North Easterly of North through said sect 2, and through sect 35, and part of sect 26 terminating in main Ditch about the Centre of the N.W. 1/4 of said sect 26 all in Township 32, R. 22, also Branch beginning at the N.W. 1/4 of sect 2, Township 32, R. 22, and terminating at main Ditch about the Centre of said sect 2, from 32, 32, 22, Now, if the said East, East, and My Wife Hoffmann
