Came personally before me Granville S. Pease, and being duly sworn deposes and says, that he now is and during all the time hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher and printer of the Anoka County UNION, a weekly newspaper printed and published in Anoka, in said Anoka County, on Wednesday

**AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF**  
 Petition. State of Minnesota, County of Anoka, ss.  
 Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said county of Anoka at their session held on the 25th day of February, 1899, upon the petition of Yost, A. Hoffman, Aug. Lundeen, John Yost, Andrew Nolz, and others, bearing date the 24th day of November, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.  
 Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their regular session to be held at the court house in the city of Anoka in said county, on the 12th day of August, 1899, at 10 o'clock a. m.  
 The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Com. at the sw cor. of sec. No. 3, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running in a north-easterly direction through said sec. No. 3, into and through secs. No. 34 and 35, and part of sec. No. 26, terminating in Co. ditch No. 12 at the center of said sec. 26, all in T. 33, R. 22, and with such branch or branches as the viewers may deem necessary to give the lands assessed for the construction of said ditch the full benefit thereof.  
 Branch No. 1, beginning at the w $\frac{1}{4}$  post of sec. 2, T. 32, R. 22; th running n. easterly of north through said sec. 2, and through sec. 35 and part of sec. 26, terminating in main ditch about the center of the southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said sec. 26, all in Twp. 33, Range 22.  
 Branch No. 2, beginning about the center of the ne $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 10, running n. westerly through said quarter sec. into sec. 3, and terminating in main ditch about the center of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3, all in Twp. 33, R. 22.  
 Branch No. 3, beginning near the center of the ne $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 4, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running in a n. easterly direction and terminating in main ditch near the center of n $\frac{1}{2}$  of nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3, Twp. 32, Range 22.  
 Branch No. 4, beginning near the w. line of the ne $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running s. westerly in s $\frac{1}{2}$  of nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3; th northw. and terminating in main ditch near the w. line of the nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of ne $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 3, Twp. 32, R. 22.  
 Branch No. 5, beginning near the center of sec. 33, Twp. 33, R. 22; thence running northeasterly through nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 34 and ne $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 34, T. 33, R. 22, and terminating in main ditch, near the center of sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sec. 26, Twp. 33, Range 22.

That he knows of his own knowledge that the printed notice of Auditor's Notice hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each week for three successive weeks, and that all said publications were made in the English language. That said notice was first inserted, printed and published in said newspaper on Wednesday, the 12 day of July, 1899, and was printed and published therein on each and every Wednesday thereafter until and including Wednesday, the 26 day of July, 1899; that during all the time aforesaid said newspaper was a collection of general and local news, comments and miscellaneous literary items, and regularly issued and published on Wednesday of each week from a known office of publication, said office being equipped with the necessary materials, including press, and skilled workmen for producing the same, and has consisted of not less than four pages, of more than five columns to the page, each column not less than seventeen and three-fourths inches in length, and never made up wholly of patents, plates and advertisements, or either or any of them, and has not been substantially a duplicate of any other newspaper, and has been regularly delivered each week to more than two-hundred and forty paid subscribers, and that said newspaper, composed and consisting as above set forth, was printed and published in the English language weekly, and generally circulated in Anoka county for more than one year next preceding the date of the first publication of said notice. That the publisher of said newspaper on the 3rd day of May, 1893, filed with the County Auditor of said Anoka County, an affidavit setting forth the facts required by Section 2, of Chapter 33, of the laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.
