Notice is hereby given, that, on the 7th day of October, 1899, at 10 o'clock, a. m., at the County Auditor's office, in the Court House, in the city of Anoka, Anoka county, Minn., I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 35 of Anoka county, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka county, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date August 12th, 1899, viz.: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source, Station 0 to 170 plus 53 inclusive, Main line, commencing at southwest corner of section number 3, Town 32, Range 22; thence north easterly through section 3 into and through section 34 and 35 and part of section number 26, terminating in Co. Ditch No. 12 at the center of section 26, all in Town 33, Range 22.

Branch No. 1 beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ post of section 2, Town 32, Range 22, thence running north-easterly through section 2 and through section 35 and part of section 26, terminating in main ditch about the center of the $\frac{sw}{4}$ of section 26, Town 33, Range 22.

Branch No. 2 beginning about the center of $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 10, running north westerly through said quarter section into section 3 and terminating in main ditch about the center of $\frac{sw}{4}$ of section 3, Town 33, Range 22.

Branch No. 3 beginning near the center of the $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 4, Town 32, Range 22; thence running in a north easterly direction and terminating in main ditch near the center of $\frac{n}{2}$ of $\frac{nw}{4}$ of section 3, Town 32, Range 22.

Branch No. 4 beginning near the west line of the $\frac{ne}{4}$ of $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 3, Town 32, Range 22; thence south westerly in $\frac{s}{4}$ of $\frac{nw}{4}$ of section 3; thence northerly and terminating in main ditch near west line of the $\frac{nw}{4}$ of $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 3, Town 32, Range 22.

Branch No. 5 beginning near the center of section 33, Town 33, Range 22; thence running north easterly through $\frac{nw}{4}$ of section 34 and $\frac{ne}{4}$ of section 34, Town 33, Range 22 and terminating in main ditch near the center of $\frac{sw}{4}$ of $\frac{sw}{4}$ of section 26, Town 33, Range 22 to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
