Witness, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said county of Anoka at their session held on the 27th day of February, 1899, upon the petition of Yost, Yost, Hermann, Aug. Lundeen, John Yost, Andrew A. Holmstrom bearing date the 24th day of November, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch, and the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.

Now therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners at their next session to be held at the court house in the city of Anoka in said county, on the 10th day of July, 1899, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Comm. at the SW cor. of sec. No. 3, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running in a westerly direction through said sec. No. 3, and through secs. No. 34 and 35, and part of sec. No. 28, terminating in Co. ditch No. 12 at the center of said sec. 28, all in T. 32, R. 22, and with such branch or branches as the viewers may deem necessary to give the lands assessed for the construction of said ditch the full benefit thereof.

Branch No. 1, beginning at the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> post of sec. 2, T. 32, R. 22; th running in easterly of north through said sec. 2 and thence sec. 35 and part of sec. 28, terminating in main ditch about the center of the southwest <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said sec. 35, all in Twp. 33, Range 22.

Branch No. 2, beginning about the center of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 10, running in westerly through main ditch about the center of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 8, all in Twp. 33, R. 22.

Branch No. 3, beginning near the center of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 4, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running in a westerly direction and terminating in main ditch near the center of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 3, Twp. 32, Range 22.

Branch No. 4, beginning near the W. line of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 3, Twp. 32, R. 22; th running S. westerly in S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 3, th northerly and terminating in main ditch near the W. line of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 3, Twp. 32, Range 22.

Branch No. 5, beginning near the center of sec. 33, Twp. 33, R. 22; thence running northeasterly through NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 34 and NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 33, T. 33, R. 22, and terminating in main ditch near the center of SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of sec. 28, Twp. 33, Range 22.
