PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Scott
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a ditch along the following described route in the Town of Buxton in said county of Scott

and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows.

Commencing at or near the North East corner of the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section No. twenty (20) Town No. thirty three (33) Range twenty three (23) and running in a generally southerly direction through the West one half (1/2) of said Section twenty (20) and the North West quarter (1/4) of Section twenty nine (29) of said Town and Range and terminating at located north near the center of said Section thirty nine (39) as is shown - A gutter with such brand drains as the Director may deem necessary to give the lands around for the construction of said ditch the full benefit thereof.
