Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka, at their session held on the 25th day of February, 1899, upon the petition of John M. Starkey, Jeff. Starkey, Wm. D. Day, W. R. Fowler, and others, bearing date the 10th day of July, 1898, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office, said ditch to be numbered 36.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their regular session to be held at the court house in the city of Anoka in said county, on the 12th day of August, 1899, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows:

Main ditch, commencing at or near the ne corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of sec. No. 20, Town No. 33, Range 23, and running in a generally southerly direction through the west one-half (1/2) of said sec. 20, and the northwest quarter of sec. 29 of said Town and Range.

Branch No. 1, com. on the south line of the sw 1/4 of ne 1/4 of sec. 20.

Branch No. 2, on the quarter sec. line in the se 1/4 of sec. 20.

Branch No. 3, on the s line of s 1/2 of sw 1/4 sec. 20, all in Twp. 33, Range 23.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows; Jefferson Starkey, St. Paul & Duluth Ry. Co., Eugene Sherwood, Fannie Douglas, Lucy Douglass, W. D. Day, W. R. Gillis.
