Notice is hereby given, that, on the 7th day of October, 1899, at 2 o'clock p. m., at the County Auditor's office, in the Court House, in the city of Anoka, Anoka county, Minn., I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 26 of Anoka county, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka county, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date August 12th, 1899, viz.: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source; station 0 to station 86 inclusive, Main line commencing at or near the north east corner of the nw $\frac{1}{4}$ of the nw $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 20, Town 33, Range 23 and running in a southerly direction through the w $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 20 and the nw $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 29 of said town and range and terminating in Crooked Brook near the center of said section 29.
