To the Board of County Commissioners of *Lincoln Co.*, Minn.

In compliance with your order dated the *25th* day of *February*

A. D. 18*99*, appointing the undersigned Viewers to survey and locate a ditch, drain, or water course, with *such branches as may be necessary*

described in the copy of the petition, accompanying said order. We do hereby respectfully report, that

we did meet at the time and place specified in said order, to-wit: On the *fourth* day of

~~April~~ *March* A. D. 18*99*, at *the Camp House*

in Center with a Surveyor, who was a civil engineer preparatory to the

commencement of said work, and did make an accurate survey of said ditch, drain, or water course, and of *its branches*

from *them* respective sources to *their* outlets, as given in the

Plat thereof, attached hereto, marked "Exhibit 'A,' of Ditch No. *36*" and made a part

of this Report; and did cause stakes to be set along the line of said ditch, drain, or water course, and

its branches

said stakes numbered progressively down stream at each one hundred (100) feet; and we have in tabular form given the depth of cut of said ditch, drain, or water course, and of *its*

branches

with at the bottom, width at the top at *their* respective sources and outlets and at each

one hundred (100) foot stake thereof; and have made a computation of the number of cubic yards

of earth to be excavated and removed from said ditch, and of *its branches*

between each the one hundred (100) foot

stakes, and the estimated cost per cubic yard for the removal thereof; and that we have correctly and

accurately summed up the total number of cubic yards of earth to be excavated and removed for the

entire length of said ditch, and of *its branches*

and have made an estimate of the total cost of laying out, establishing and construction of the whole

work, as shown in our report thereof, attached hereto and marked "Exhibit 'B,' of Ditch No. *36*"

and made a part of this Report

We have also specified the time and manner in which the work shall be done, as shown in our report thereof, attached hereto, and marked "Exhibit 'C,' of Ditch No. *36*" and made a part of this Report

We have filed with this Report an account of the names of the laborers and the time each was employed by us, and every other item of expense by us incurred in and about said work, which said account is marked "Exhibit 'D' of Ditch No. 36" attached hereto

And we have given in tabular form the names of the owners of each tract of land, to be benefited or damaged, the description of each tract benefited or damaged, (said names of owners and descriptions being the same as appears on the County Tax duplicates of said County of Minnesota), and the total number of acres in each of said tracts,

the estimated number of acres in each of said tracts of land to be benefited or damaged (as the case may be), and the amount that each tract of land will be benefited or damaged by the construction of said work.

We have also annex hereto ~~and to Town & County~~ Books and Charges paid against the same represents for their maintenance - do not - the sum of Dollars —

and also the total estimated benefits to be shown in our report thereof, attached hereto, and marked "Exhibit 'E' of Ditch No. 36" and made a part of this Report in the price paid to amount to \$609.11
the cost of construction " \$503.41

And we would respectfully report that in our opinion the estimated expense of the construction of such ditch and therefor including the damages awarded therefor

are less than the utility of the proposed ditch to prevent its construction and in the therefor we recommend that the price of the land to be granted
