This Contract, Made this 30th day of April 1900

by and between Ho B. Stevens of Anoka party of the first part, and Delbert Mc Caffey County Auditor of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in behalf of Anoka County, Minnesota, WITNESSETH: Anoka

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch designated as No. 37 which number has been given to said Ditch by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 17th day of February 1900, and according to the report of the viewers Delbert Mc Caffey thereof, all of which are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

And Whereas, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, commencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source, held April 14th 1900, the said Delbert Mc Caffey County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said Ho. B. Stevens he being the highest and best responsible bidder, the job of digging and constructing the following sections thereof, numbered as follows from said outlet, to-wit: Station 178 to Station 212 in 1/4 more or less at the price amounting in the amount to One hundred sixty three 49/100 dollars (\$163.49)

Now, in Consideration of the Said Premises, The said Ho. B. Stevens hereby contracts and agrees to construct such share or allotment in the time and manner set forth in said order and the report of said viewers on which said Ditch was established, and so on file as aforesaid,
