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PRINTER'S AFFIDAVIT.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, }
COUNTY OF ANOKA. } ss.

Came personally before me Granville S. Pease, and being duly sworn deposes and says, that he now is and during all the time hereinafter mentioned has been the publisher and printer of the Anoka County UNION, a weekly newspaper printed and published in Anoka, in said Anoka County, on Wednesday

of each week. That he knows of his own knowledge that the printed notice of Auditor's notice of

Pendency of Petition hereto attached, cut from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each

week for three successive weeks, and that all said publications were made in the English language. That said notice was first inserted, printed and published in said

newspaper on Wednesday, the 29th day of August 1900, and was printed and

published therein on each and every Wednesday thereafter until and including Wednesday, the 12th day of Sept. 1900

1900; that during all the time aforesaid said newspaper

was a collection of general and local news, comments and miscellaneous literary items, and regularly issued and published on Wednesday of each week from a known office of publica-

tion, said office being equipped with the necessary materials, including press, and skilled workmen for producing the same, and has consisted of not less than four pages, of more than

five columns to the page, each column not less than seventeen and three-fourths inches in length, and never made up wholly of patents, plates and advertisements, or either or any of them,

and has not been substantially a duplicate of any other newspaper, and has been regularly delivered each week to more than two-hundred and forty paid subscribers, and that said newspaper, composed and consisting as above set forth, was

printed and published in the English language weekly, and generally circulated in Anoka county for more than one year next preceding the date of the first publication of said notice. That the publisher of said newspaper on the 3rd day of May, 1893, filed with the County Auditor of said Anoka County, an affidavit setting forth the facts required by Section 2, of Chapter 33, of the laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.

AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDING OF PETITION.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, }
County of Anoka, } ss.

Whereas, the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka, at their session held on the 16th day of April, 1900, upon the petition of August Holmquist, Dennis Dee and others, bearing date the 16th day of January, 1900, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public Ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their special session to be held at the Auditor's Office, in the city of Anoka, in said county, on the 22nd day of September, 1900, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said Ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing at a point on the east line of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section thirty-four township thirty-three, range twenty-three, and running northwesterly through section twenty-eight to a point at or near the west line of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section twenty-eight, township thirty-three, of range twenty-three, and there terminating in Crooked brook (so called), also any branch that may be deemed necessary.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed Ditch passes are as follows: Dennis Dee, Mary Cogger, Gust Carlson, John Holmquist, I. W. Smith, et. al.

The place of termination of said Ditch at its outlet is as follows: In Crooked brook (so called), at or near the west line of section 28, township 33, range 23.

The names of the owners of the lands that will be affected thereby as shown by the latest tax duplicates of said County are: I. W. Smith et. al., Dennis Dee, Mary Cogger, Gust Carlson, John Holmquist.
