 State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Public Ditch, hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Public Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Butte in said County of Le Sueur and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said Public Ditch is as follows:
 Commencing at apoint on the east line of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of section thirty four township thirty three range twenty three and running easterly through section thirty eight, to a point at or near the east line of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of said section thirty eight township thirty three of Range thirty three T. Three Sec. thirty six and thence south (or across) also on ground that may be deemed necessary.
