PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cook
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the Public Ditch or water Course hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Public Ditch or water Course along the following described route in the Town of Osage
