Whereas, The petition of Henry Del and others, bearing date the 12th day of April 1902, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public High along the route proposed therein, has been filed in my office,

Now, therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their Special session to be held at Auditors Office in the City of Carver in said County, on the 10 day of June 1902, at 10 o'clock a.m.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carver State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the Public High or water course hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Public High or water course along the following described route in the Town of Blaine Carver in said County of Carver

and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said High is as follows:

Commencing at Sec. 29 paid town of Blaine on land belonging to Albert Gottwald - being the SE 1/4 of Block 9 paid Sec. 29.

thence running along the following route: through Section 29-30 and 19 in said town in a northerly direction

and terminating at Grand Creek Rich in Section 18 paid town of Blaine, being in the SW 1/4 paid Section 18

as its outlet and other branches as may be deemed
necessary in the opinion of the viewers

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such click or walk cases
and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Fifty-eight (258) of
the General Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and subsequent amendments thereto.
