AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDING OF PETITION.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, } ss.
County of Ancker.

Whereas the petition of Henry Lee and others,
bearing date the 12th day of April, 1902, and on
file in my office, praying for the establishment of
a public ditch along the route proposed therein,
has been filed in my office.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the
pendency of said petition, and that the same will
be heard and determined before the said Board
of County Commissioners, at their special ses-
sion to be held at Auditor's office, in the City of
Austin, in said County, on the 2nd day of June,
1902, at 10 o'clock a. m.

A true copy of said petition is as follows: to-
wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the
County of Ancker, State of Minnesota:
The undersigned land owners, whose lands
will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for
the expense of the construction of the public
ditch or water course hereinafter described,
would respectfully represent that the public
health, convenience and well fare require the
establishment and construction of a public
ditch or water course along the following de-
scribed route in the town of Blaine in
said County of Ancker and that
the construction of the same would be of public
benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting
point, route and terminus of said ditch is as
follows: Commencing in sec. 29, said town of Blaine on
land belonging to Albert Gottwaldt, being the
SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of said section 29, thence
running along the following route:
through section 29, 28 and 19 in said town
in a northerly direction and terminating at Sand
beak Ditch in section 18, said town of Blaine,
let and other branches as may be deemed nec-
essary in the opinion of the viewers.

And you petitioners pray that you will pro-
ceed to establish such ditch or water course and
chanter to be constructed as provided by
General Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and sub-
sequent amendments thereto.
