Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

Whereas, The owners of certain lands in the Town of Ham Lake of said Anoka County, upon the petition of John Johnson, Peter Lundberg, Michael Envoll, Peter Peterson and Charles A. Magnuson, bearing date the 30th day of January, 1889, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, Therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the Court House in Anoka, on the eighth day of June, 1889, at 10 o'clock A. M. The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: in the nw¼ of the se¼ of Section 4, Town 22, Range 23, through se¼ of Section 4, through Section 9, and n½ of se¼ Section 8, said Town and Range.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: Peter Lundberg, J. T. Elwell and Olaf Peterson.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: at head of ditch petitioned for by O. Heglund and others near the centre of Section 8, Town 22, Range 23.
