2 as John Johnson Ditch was opened at the County  
3 Auditor's Office in the Court House in the City of  
4 Anoka Minn August 3<sup>d</sup> 1889 at 10 o'clock A. M., by  
5 reading the annexed printed advertisement and this  
6 notice. "This sale of ditching jobs is offered in 100 ft  
7 sections by the yard. The estimate of the Viewers  
8 as made by them and on file to be taken as the  
9 number of yards between the stakes as numbered by  
10 them."

### SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

14 Notice is hereby given, that, on the 3d day of  
15 August, 1889, at 10 o'clock a. m., at the County  
16 Auditor's office, in the city of Anoka, Minn., I  
17 will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the  
18 ditch No. 4, (known as John Johnson ditch), of  
19 Anoka county, established by the Board of  
20 County Commissioners of Anoka county, State  
21 of Minnesota, by their order bearing date June  
22 8th, 1889, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each  
of said sections to be known and numbered by  
stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in  
said matter, commencing at the one including  
the outlet, and from thence, successively, up  
stream to the one including the source. The  
place of commencement of said ditch, at its  
source, is as follows: In the north part of nw $\frac{1}{4}$   
of se $\frac{1}{4}$ , of section 4, township 32, range 23, thence  
through the se $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 4, through n $\frac{1}{2}$  of  
section 9, and nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 9,  
through n $\frac{1}{2}$  of se $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 8, terminating in  
ditch No. 2, (called Heglund ditch), in said sec-  
tion 8, all being in township 32, range 23, to the  
lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work  
to be completed within the time required, and in  
the manner specified, in said viewer's report.  
And no bid will be entertained which exceeds  
more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the  
estimated cost of the construction, in any case,  
as stated in the said order; and the successful  
bidder will be required to give a satisfactory  
bond, with two freehold securities, for the faith-  
ful performance and fulfillment of his contract,  
and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason  
of his failure to complete the job within the time  
required in the contract. The said order and es-
