Now, therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the
same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their
regular session to be held at Anoka office in the City
of Anoka in said County, on the 13th day of
July 1903, at 10 o'clock a.m.
A true copy of said petition is as follows, to-wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for
the expense of, the construction of the public ditch or water course
hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare
require the establishment and construction of a public ditch or water course
along the following described route in the Town of Anoka
in said County of Anoka

and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.
A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch
is as follows:

Commencing at a point about twenty rods south of the south
end of Long Lake so-called in lot numbered two
(2) of section twenty five (25) Township Twenty four
(34) Range twenty two (22) West

thence running along the following route: West in a generally southerly
course for a distance of about two hundred (200)
rods, thence in an easterly and southerly direction
along a natural water course to a point where said
water course passes under the road known as the
Linnwood and Stacy wagon road

and terminating at said last named point, the above described
water course

as its outlet into the middle branch or called

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such *Public ditch* and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Fifty-eight (258) of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and subsequent amendments thereto.
