PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a public drain or ditch along the following described route in the Town of Simons in said County of Anoka

and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said public ditch is as follows:

Commencing at a point about west side corner of the south end of long rocks so-called, in Block number 112, of Section Twenty Five (205) Township Thirty Four (34) Range Twenty Two (22), West,

thence running along the following route: with a generally southwesterly course for a distance of about two hundred (200) feet; thence in an easterly and southerly direction along a natural water course to a point where said water course crosses under the road known as the Remond and Blay wagon road.

and terminating at said last named point. The above described water course acting

as its outlet into the Middle Branch, so-called,
