TAKE NOTICE, that the undersigned, William C. Tigue of Anoka County, Minnesota, the purchaser of the following described premises under a contract for a deed thereof, and being in possession and control thereof, deeming himself aggrieved and being in fact aggrieved by the Order of the County Board of said County of Anoka, in said State, in the above entitled matter, made and filed in the County Auditor's Office in and for said County of Anoka, in said State, on the 10th day of August, 1917, in and by the terms of which said order the assessment of benefits and damages to said lands, hereinafter described, on account of the ~~construction~~ and repair of said ditch, said ditch being known as Ditch No. 41, was confirmed, fixed and determined as follows: the amount of benefits assessed and determined to said lands, which are the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Eleven (11), Township Thirty-one (31), Range Twenty-four (24), Anoka County, Minnesota, except Railroad right of way, as nothing, and the amount of damages assessed and determined thereto as \$30.00, all by reason of the ~~construction and~~ repair of said ditch, hereby appeals from said Order so confirming said assessment and fixing and determining said amounts of benefits and damages as aforesaid and as in said order described, on account of the ~~construction and~~ repair of said ditch, to the District Court in and for said County of Anoka, State of Minnesota. Said William C. Tigue further states that such appeal is made as aforesaid on the grounds and for the reason that the assessed and determined damages to the aforesaid lands is less than the actual damages to said lands on account of the ~~construction and~~ repair of said ditch.
