THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas A. Matushak and others have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the repair of a public ditch, which ditch is known as County Ditch No. 41, and a Civil Engineer has been appointed by the County Board of said County, to survey the same and said engineer has filed his report thereon; and also viewers have been appointed who have reported thereon, and the County Board of said County, have by their order bearing date the 10th day of August, A. D. 1917, confirmed the said viewers' report, and the above bounden William C. Tigue has appealed to the District Court aforesaid from said order of said County Board confirming said viewers' report, which order is dated August 10th, 1917.

Now, If the said William C. Tigue shall duly prosecute said appeal, and shall pay all costs and disbursements that may be adjudged against him and abide the order of said Court if the action of said County Board shall be sustained by the District Court aforesaid, then

the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
