This Agreement made this 24th day of May, 1905, by and between
E. P. Woodworth of Anoka County, Minnesota, party of the first part, and
The Anoka National Bank, a corporation organized under the laws of the
United States, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, whereas said party of the first part has an assignment
of a contract with the Board of County Commissioners of the County of
Anoka in the State of Minnesota, which contract is known and described
as Anoka Ditch Contract No. 41, the same being for the digging of a ditch
and bridges and branches in connection therewith, in the town of Blaine
in said Anoka County. And whereas said work is now partly completed
and the work is now being carried on by sub-contractors. *very only*

And whereas, I, the party of the first ^{part}, ~~am~~ indebted to said
Anoka National Bank, the party of the second part, in the sum of
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars which is represented by a promissory note
for that sum, signed by E. P. Woodworth, bearing date of the 24th day
of May, 1905 and payable October 1st, 1905.

Now therefore, as collateral security to secure the payment of said
note, I do hereby assign, transfer and set over to the said Anoka National
Bank all money due or to come due to ~~me~~ under said Anoka Ditch Contract
No. 41 on the final estimate.

And I do hereby authorize and direct that payment for that portion
of the work under said Anoka Ditch Contract No. 41 which is hereby assigned
be paid to the said Anoka National Bank.

This assignment made this 2nd day of January, 1905, by E. S. St Martin, K. H. Davis and F. A. Vessey as co-partners in business as contractors in ditch digging under the firm name of St Martin, Davis & Vessey, parties of the first part, ^{to} ~~and~~ Minnie Vessey and Margaret A. Vessey, parties of the second part,

Witnesseth :-

Whereas said parties of the first part have a contract with the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota, which contract is known and described as Anoka Ditch Contract No. 41, the same being for the digging of a ditch, and bridges and branches in connection therewith, in the town of Blaine in said Anoka County. And whereas said work is now partly completed, and the work is now being carried on by sub-contractors/under us; and, for the work already done by us, we have only been able to draw fifty per cent, and the balance is to be paid us when the contract is completed.

And whereas we, the parties of the first part, are indebted to said Minnie Vessey, one of the parties of the second part, in the sum of \$500.10 which is represented by a promissory note for that sum, signed by us both individually and as partners, bearing date January 2, 1905, and payable on or before Sept. 2, 1905; and we are also indebted to Margaret A. Vessey, the other party of the second part, in the sum of \$309.40 which is represented by a promissory note for that sum, signed by us both individually and as partners, bearing date January 2, 1905, and payable ~~Sept. 2, 1905~~ on or before Sept. 2, 1905; both said notes bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from date until paid.

Now therefore, as collateral security to secure the payment of said notes, we do hereby assign, transfer and set over to the said Minnie Vessey and Margaret A. Vessey all money due or to come due to us under said Anoka Ditch contract No. 41 for all work done, or to be done, on that portion of said ditch known and described as Stations Number 302 to 359, both inclusive on the main ditch, and also on the two bridges which are included within the stretch of the main ditch from station 302 to 359 both inclusive. For more particular description reference is made to preliminary survey or surveys in the office of the County Auditor of said Anoka County.

x And we, the parties of the first part, do hereby state that the work upon
that portion of the contract hereby assigned has been completed by us, and
the balance now remaining due us for that portion of the work under said con-
tract, as stated to us by the supervising engineer, is \$940.05; and we do here-
by covenant and agree that we will well and faithfully see to it that the
entire contract is carried out and completed.

And we do hereby authorize and direct that payment for that portion of
the work under said Anoka Ditch Contract No. 41 which is hereby assigned be
paid to said Minnie Vessey and Margaret A. Vessey.
