December 10, 1945

The petition of B. B. Nelson, et al having been filed in the office of the County Auditor on the 10th day of December, 1945 and presented to the Board of County Commissioners on the 10th day of December, 1945, stating that the drainage system No. 41 in the County of Anoka, Minnesota is insufficient and praying the appointment of an engineer to examine the same and report thereon and that such further proceedings be had as shall be found necessary.

Commissioner Ward offered the following resolution and moved its adoption which motion was seconded by Commissioner Peterson:

IT IS ORDERED That R. G. Streetley be, and he hereby is, appointed as civil engineer to examine said drainage system, to make a survey thereof if he shall find it necessary, to ascertain the character, extent, and costs of the necessary repair and improvement of said drainage system, and make a full report thereon according to law as soon as practicable; that he commence such examination and survey as soon as practicable, and that before entering upon such duties he give bond, approved by the County Board to said county in the sum of \$5,000.00 payable to said county for the benefit thereof and also for the use of all parties who may become aggrieved or injured by any negligence or malfeasance on his part, and conditioned that he will diligently, honestly and to the best of his skill and ability perform his duties as such engineer in this proceeding. Motion carried.
