Whereas, A petition bearing date the 12th day of June 1904, signed by G. J. Swanam, Ruel and Nelson Parker and Johnson and George Blake and Mrs. A. M. Wehaka and Jay - Ryan praying for the establishment of a certain public ditch in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And whereas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Quincy County, that ~~at least thirty~~ notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

~~And whereas, said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit and conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare;~~

Now, therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a special session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint G. J. Parker (Big), R. R. Riehray (Bain) and Robert - Paulsen (Bain)

three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 16th day of April 1904, at the Court House in the City of Quincy as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 10th day of May 1904
