dency of Petition.

Whereas, the petition of G. J. Swanson and oth-
ers, bearing date the 12th day of June, 1903, and
on file in my office, praying for the establishment
of a public ditch along the route proposed there-
in, has been filed in my office.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the
pendency of said petition, and that the same will
be heard and determined before the said Board
of County Commissioners, at their special ses-
sion to be held at the Auditor's office in the City
of Anoka, on Saturday, the 10th day of Sep-
tember, 1903, at 10 o'clock a. m.
A true copy of said petition is as follows, to-
wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the
County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:
The undersigned land owners, whose lands will
be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the ex-
pense of, the construction of the ditch hereinaf-
ter described, would respectfully represent that
the public health, convenience and welfare re-
quire the establishment and construction of a
ditch of ample capacity to drain the land along
the following described route in the Towns of
Blaine and Anoka, in said County of Anoka, and
that the construction of the same would be of
public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting
point, route and terminus of said ditch is as fol-
lows:

Commencing at a point near the center of sec-
tion thirty-three in the Town of Blaine, thence
running along the following route: Northwest-
erly, northerly and westerly through sections
twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29), sixteen (16),
seventeen (17), eight (8), seven (7), six (6),
(7), in the Town of Blaine, and through the
southeast quarter of twelve (12) in Town of An-
oka and emptying into Sand Creek at or near the
south line of section thirty-four (34) and seven-
teen (17) and thence (15) in said Town of An-
oka, with said Sand Creek as its center, also
branches from said ditch as may be found nec-
essary.

And your petitioners pray that you will pro-
ceed to establish such ditch and cause the same
to be constructed as provided by Chapter 173,
Hundred and Fifty-seventh (257) of the General
Laws of Minnesota, for 1901, and subsequent
amendments thereto.
