This assignment made this 20th day of July 1905
by E. S. H. Denton, R. H. Davis, H. C. Wesley as
Co. Partners in business as Gutzel's under the firm
name of H. Martin, Davis & Wesley. Parties of the first
part to Henry J. Coleman part of the second part
Middlet: where said parties of the first part
then a Gutzel's with the Board of Bank Commissioners
of North Carolina, which Gutzel is known and
referred as North's 21st, the same being for the
beginning of a detail, brackets and building bridge in Sumner's Territory,
in said North's Bank, and where said work is partly
completed and is being now done by E. P. Woodworth as Sub.
Contractor and said detail No. 21-10000 to be completed in
the summer of 1906. And whereas, we, the said parties of the
first part are indebted to said party of the second part in the
sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars which is represented
by two promissory notes for that sum, one for (\$1000.00) one Hundred
Dollars dated July 3rd 1905, payable on demand, and the other for
Eight Hundred (\$800.00) Dollars, due September 1st 1906 - and date
July 20th 1905, both notes drawing five per cent interest
until paid. And as transfer, as collateral security - to secure the
payments of said notes we do hereby assign, transfer and set
over to said party of the 2nd part all money due, or to come due
to us under said Gutzel's No. 21, or the prime Saltsville - Ferry.
subject to claim of Annie Margaret - Wiley under date of Dec. 2nd 1905
of the 2nd party, with copy and assign the said Bank Commissioners
of the County of Wilkes of said North's Bank, that said amount & interest
then due or hereafter due be paid to said Henry J. Coleman part
of the 2nd part
