In the matter of the petition of H. W. Douglass and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of the said Anoka County, Minnesota, praying for the construction of a public ditch through the following lands described in the engineer's report as follows:

MAIN DITCH. Commencing in the sec 1/2 of sec 4, T. 31, R. 24, 33 feet north and 56 1/2 feet west of the se corner of said section, thence running southeasterly through the ne 1/4 of ne 1/4 and southeasterly through the sec 1/2 of ne 1/4 of section 9, and continuing southeasterly through ne 1/4 of sec 1/2, sw 1/4, ne 1/4 of sec 1/2 and sec 1/2 of sec 1/2 of section 10, and continuing southeasterly through ne 1/4 and slat 50 feet into the ne 1/4 of sw 1/4 all in section 14, T. 31, R. 24, and thence ending in the main ditch in the sec 1/2 of ne 1/4, all in section 9, T. 31, R. 24.
