This is the date and hour set for the sale of the job and letting of the contract for the digging and constructing the Repairs of Ditch No.41, Anoka County.

Present; Arthur A.Caswell, County Auditor; Theo.A.E.Nelson, Clerk of District Court; Wayne L.Ridge, Ditch Engineer ; Leeds H.Cutter, Attorney for Ditch Petitioners and several bidders.

Mr. Caswell, County Auditor, announced that he had received one sealed bid, and that a recess would be taken until 2:30 P.M., in order that the other bidders present might prepare sealed bids.

Mr. Caswell announced that he had received only one sealed bid, to-wit; a bid from Cipra & Nerad and that a certified check in the amount of \$200.00 was enclosed.

The bid of Cipra & Nerad was as follows; Digging and clearing ditch 33.4 ¢ per cubic yard and \$49.00 for grubbing or a total of \$1941.44 for the job.

This being the only bid received, the contract was given to Messrs. Cipra & Nerad for the sum of \$1941.44.
