To the County Board of the County of Anoka, Minnesota:

The undersigned petitioners respectively represent and state:

That they are the owners of lands that have been heretofore assessed for the construction of County Ditch No. 41 of Anoka County.

That the said ditch is in need of repairs and that its usefulness for the purpose for which it was constructed has become greatly impaired.

First—That said ditch has become obstructed by the deposit of sediment therein and by the growth of weeds and grasses upon and along the bottom, sides, banks and right of way thereof.

Second—That by reason of the construction of side and lateral ditches emptying into said ditch the volume of water to be taken care of by said County Ditch No. 41 has been increased beyond the capacity thereof.

Third—That the capacity of said ditch is being increased by the deposit of sediment therein and by the growth of weeds and grasses upon and along the bottom, sides, banks and right of way thereof.
