PETITION.

To the County Board of the County of Anoka,
Minnesota:
The undersigned petitioners respectively rep-
resent and state:

That they are the owners of lands that have
been heretofore assessed for the construction of
County Ditch No. 41 of Anoka County.

That the said ditch is in need of repairs and
that its usefulness for the purpose for which it
was constructed has become greatly impaired by
reason of the following facts:

First—That said ditch has become obstructed
by the deposit of sediment therein and by the
growth of weeds and grasses upon and along the
bottom, sides, banks and right of way thereof.

Second—That by reason of the construction of
side and lateral ditches emptying into said ditch
the volume of water to be taken care of by said
County Ditch No. 41 has been increased beyond
the capacity thereof.

Third—That the capacity of said ditch to take
care of said additional waters should be increased
from the point where the lateral ditch enters the
main ditch near the east line of the northeast
quarter of section seventeen in township thirty-
one of range twenty-three, being the Town of
Blaine, in said Anoka County, to the outlet of said
ditch.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that you will
appoint a civil engineer to ascertain and report to
you the necessity therefor, and the cost of making
such repairs, and when such report is filed such
other and further proceedings may be had as
necessary for the repair of such ditch.
