which said sections were sold to Otis F. Doyle and by him contracted to be constructed for the total sum of Forty-five hundred ninety-four & 51/100 (4594.51) Dollars, and find that said Otis F. Doyle has performed work upon said

sections within said County of the full value of 3675.61 Dollars,

in accordance with said contract, plans and specifications of said engineer as set forth in the report of said engineer, which said work has been approved by me, and that said Otis F. Doyle is

entitled to partial payment on account of said work of 75 per cent of said value of said work already done, being the sum of Twenty-seven hundred fifty-six & 71/100 (2756.71) Dollars, to be paid to him out of the general ditch

fund of said County according to law, upon the written approval of the County Auditor of said County of the certificate this day issued by me to said Otis F. Doyle for said amount; and I certify that no loss

will result to said County by the payment of the above amount on account of said work so performed.
