Notice is hereby given that a petition, of which the following is a copy, has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, and that a hearing will be had upon said petition before the Board of County Commissioners at the office of the County Auditor of said County, on the 10th day of July A. D. 1905, at 11 o'clock A. M.

PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners

of the County of Anoka

State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Public Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare and the reclamation of wet and overflowed lands require the establishment and construction of Public Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Burns in said County of Anoka

and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows:

Commencing at the outlet of Boyer Lake, so-called near the section line between section Five (5) and ten (10), town Thirty third (33), Range Twenty Five (25) and following in a general direction the course of said outlet and down course forming through, known as Third Quart in a northwesterly and westerly direction across section ten, said town and range, through Prinsep Lake, so-called, and easterly and southerly across a portion of section seven said town and range

and terminating at the intersection of said water course with the
east end west quarter line of said section eleven (11), in said
Ford Bank

as its outlet.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Public Ditch

and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred Fifty-eight (258), of the
General Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and subsequent amendments thereto.
