PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Public Ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment ~~and~~ construction of a Public Ditch ~~with~~ in accordance with the following described route in the Town of Public Health convenience and welfare and the same within of Public Health and utility and in the undivided hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed to of public benefit and utility. and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility. in a direct, simple, permanent, desirable route in the Town of Burns in said County of Anoka. A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows:

Commencing at about thirty (30) rods South of the N. E. corner of the of Sec. 15, Town 33 Range 25, there in a generally easterly direction through said Section 15 and Sec. 14 and Town and Range to and North (so called) in the eastern part of said Section 14 and in the same terminating with such Branch Ditch or Ditches as the Board may deem necessary to give the best assured facility construction of said Ditch the full length thereof.
