To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, County of Anoka, Minnesota.

We, the undersigned, whose lands <sup>will</sup> ~~have~~ been assessed for benefits by reason of the proposed construction of ditch number forty two (42), commonly called and known as the Stromburg ditch hereby renounce against the laying out and establishment of said ditch, and as grounds of renoustrance, set forth:

1. That the cost of construction of said ditch will far exceed the benefits derived therefrom.
2. That the amounts assessed against the lands of each of the undersigned for exceeds the benefits derived from said ditch, and that the cost of constructing said ditch amounts to a practical confiscation of the land so assessed.
3. That the actual benefits derived from the proposed construction of said ditch to each of the undersigned is far less than the amount ~~to~~ taxed against said lands.
