Arthur E. Morgan as a competent and experienced engineer to make with E. R. Jamsted and J. W. Youngdale as his assistants at an accurate survey of the line of said ditch from its source to its outlet, as the same salary as he is to receive, and Miss Jessie B. Morgan, stenographer and office assistant at a rate of \$57.00 of the General Laws of 1905, and after completing his duties as such engineer to make and file his report with the County Auditor of said County, ~~on or~~ before the 11th day of August 1901.
