I will sell the jobs and let the contracts for digging and constructing the Ditch No. 45, of

Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of

Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date

And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction of the part of said work covered by such bid; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond in a sum not less than the contract price, to be approved by the Auditor of said County, with two freehold sureties, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.

All bids must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the Auditor of said County, for not less than ten per cent of the amount of each bid.
