A VIEWER'S NOTICE OF HEARING AFTER

Viewers' Report in Ditch Proceedings.

In the matter of the petition of Hudson Gray and others for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota:

Notice is hereby given, that, whereas, a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the establishment and construction of the ditch herein referred to, and the civil engineer appointed by the board of county commissioners of said county to make a survey of the route of said ditch has completed his work and made due report thereof and filed said report in the office of the county auditor of said county, and the viewers appointed by said board of county commissioners to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereof in the office of said county auditor, which ditch as specified and laid out in said petition, said report of said engineer, and the report of said viewers, commencing at station O, whence 1.8 section post, center of the N. E. 1/4 Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24, bears west 135 feet, as its source, and runs thence along the following route, to-wit: westerly and northerly through N. E. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of Sec. 36, N. W. 1/4 of N. E. 1/4, Sec. 35, and northerly through Swan Lake to lot 6, Sec. 25, thence northerly through said lot 6 and westerly through the N. W. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 Sec. 26, and the N. E. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 Sec. 26 to railroad right of way; thence on and along said right of way to culvert presently through east and northerly through the S. E. 1/4 of the S. E. 1/4 Sec. 23 to Cedar Creek in the N. W. 1/4 portion of said S. E. 1/4, and terminating in said Cedar Creek as its outlet; and has certain proposed branches the details of which are set forth in the following report, sources and termini of which are as follows, to-wit: Branch No. 1, commencing at station O, branch No. 1 in the east and west road on the north line of the M.
