The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch and branches hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of s public ditch and branches along the following described route in the Town of Oak Grove in said county of Anoka, and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility; and is necessary for the following reasons, among others, to-wit: That large acres of land along the course of the proposed ditch are now wet, overflowed and rendered useless for any purpose, which by the construction of the proposed ditch would be rendered productive and useful for farming and other purposes, and large quantities of stagnant water which now constitute a menace to public health would be removed by said proposed ditch.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said public ditch is as follows:
