

In the matter of the petition of N. O. Rumbly and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

Whereas, a petition has been filed bearing date the 9th day of July, 1906, praying for the establishment of a public ditch in said County, along the route described in said petition, together with the proper bond accompanying the same, and the said petition has been heard and considered by the Board of County Commissioners of said County at their meeting held on the 18th day of October, 1906, pursuant to notice of said hearing duly published and posted, as by law required, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed a competent engineer, to-wit: J. E. Hill, to make a complete survey of said public ditch and of the route thereof, who has on the 19th day of April, 1907, filed his report of said survey in my office, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed Richard Riekaby, and Peter Kammerer and John A. Houle to be viewers of said proposed public ditch by their order filed therein in my office on the 18th day of October, 1906:

Now, therefore, it is ordered that the said viewers be and meet at the Auditor's office in the City of Anoka in said County on the 24th day of April, A.D. 1907, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon of said day, preparatory to assuming and commencing their duties as such viewers, said time being within fifteen days after the filing of the engineer's report of his survey in said matter.

PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota;

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch and branches hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a public ditch and branches, along the following described route in the town of Columbus, in said County of Anoka: that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit: that large areas of land along the course of the proposed ditch and branches are now wet, overflowed and rendered useless and of small value for farming and other purposes, which, by the establishment and construction of the proposed ditch and branches, would be drained, improved and rendered useful and of great value for farming and other purposes, and the public health would be improved by the removal of large quantities of stagnant water along the course of the proposed ditch and branches.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows:

Commencing at lowest point in marsh near the center of the S.E.1/4 of the N.E.1/4 of Sec. 16, Twp. 52, Rnge. 22, thence running along the following route: southwesterly across said S.E.1/4 of N.E.1/4 of said Sec. 16, and across corner of the S.W.1/4 of the N.E.1/4 of said Sec. 16, and southerly across the west half of the S.E.1/4 of said Sec. 16, and southeasterly across the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 21, said town and range, and easterly across the Northwest Quarter of Sec. 22, said town and range, to Columbus Lake, so-called, and through said Columbus Lake to its outlet, and Lake, so-called, and through said Columbus Lake to its outlet, and following generally the course of the outlet creek of said Columbus Lake, to Rice Creek, in Section 25, said Town and Range, and terminating in said Rice Creek in said Section as its outlet. Also such branch or branches as may be necessary and proper to render said ditch most useful, effectual and beneficial.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such public ditch and branches and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Thirty (230) of the General Laws of 1905, Chapter 44 of the Revised Laws of 1905, and the laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

The said viewers shall also file in said office of the County Auditor of said county a report of all their doings in detail, including expenses and the actual time they were engaged, and perform every duty imposed upon them by and in accordance with Chapter 230 of the General Laws of 1905, within the time hereinbefore specified, which shall be not more than thirty days from the date of their first meeting as the said date shall be set by the said order of the said County Auditor.
