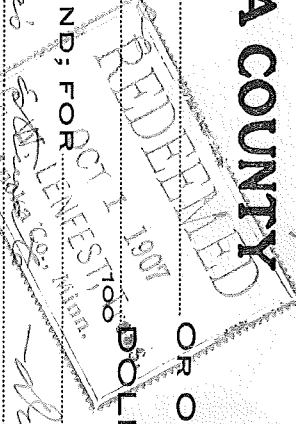

The amount of the contract price for these sections is Five Hundred and Seven Dollars and Seventy Four Cents (\$507.74)

The above work was let to Joseph Laroux by the County Auditor of the said county and contracted to be done by him, and I do certify that the said sections are a part of the said contract and are nearly completed according to contract, plans and specifications of the said engineer as set forth in the report of the said engineer, and I do respectfully recommend that a payment of Seventy Five per cent (75%) of the contract price be paid to said Joseph Laroux as a partial payment on his contract with the said County of Anoka,
