The Condition of the Above Obligation is such, That whereas the above bounden
Joseph Wittmann and Clara

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Dakota County, State of
Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch and branches

along the following described route: Commencing at level point in marsh
near the center of the S.E. 1/4 of T16 N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 16 Twp. 32 Range 22,
thence running along the following route: easterly across said S.E. 1/4
of N.E. 1/4 of said Sec 16, and across corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of said Sec 16,
and southerly across the West half of the S.E. 1/4 of said Sec 16, and
easterly across the north half of the S.E. 1/4 of said Sec 16, and
easterly across the north half of Sec 21, said Twp. and range to
Columbus Lake, so-called, and through said Columbus Lake to its
out-let, and following generally the course of the outlet creek of
said Columbus Lake, to Rice Creek in Section Twenty-Three and
from said Range and terminating in said Rice Creek in
said section as its-outlet; also such branch or branches as
